Much work went into preparing the space in the months before opening – cleaning, painting, pulling up carpet to reveal our tile floor, and getting everything in working order. We greatly appreciate the many contributions from members of this community who helped us to get this space in shape!

The Riverwest Public House has hosted a wide variety of events, including music ranging from punk to bluegrass, plays, films, debates, and discussions. We look forward to being here and serving our neighborhood for many years to come. We are only as strong as our membership and volunteer base, so get involved however you can, and help shape the future of your Public House.

The mission of the Riverwest Public House Cooperative is three-fold: to provide a welcoming social meeting place, to provide patrons with a variety of affordable local, organic and/or delicious beers, ciders and spirits, and to raise funds to propagate other cooperatives through the Riverwest Cooperative Alliance.

The Riverwest Public House Cooperative is being modeled in part after England's public houses. These pubs, which date back to the middle of the 15th century, often serve as a focal point for the locals to meet and gossip and arrange mutual help within their communities. Inspiration for the Riverwest Public House was also derived from Mondragón Cooperative Corporation, the instigator of hundreds of other cooperatives worldwide.
